STANDING ORDER NO. 9


IN FURTHERANCE OF Virgin Islands Rule of Civil Procedure 92(e)(1), for any case referred by a judge of the Superior Court of the Virgin Islands to determine whether the case should be designated as complex and transferred to the Complex Litigation Division, the Court hereby **ORDERS** that any party's submission of written briefing or appearance at a hearing in accordance with Virgin Islands Rule of Civil Procedure 92(d) **SHALL NOT** be construed as a waiver, forfeiture, or abandonment of any defense, objection, or argument, including personal jurisdiction, provided that such defense, objection, or argument was timely raised and preserved prior to the case being referred for a determination.
